

NOTICE TO LANDLORD OF EVICTION PROTECTION DUE TO COVID-19

On August 19, 2020, Kansas Governor Laura Kelly enacted Executive Order 20-61, "Temporarily prohibiting certain foreclosures and evictions."

The moratorium applies to actions initiated after August 19, 2020, and applies through September 2, 2020. However, the Governor may extend or repeal the moratorium.

This is formal notification of the below-named tenant's substantial loss of income or substantial out-of-pocket expenses related to COVID-19 and intent to seek protection under the Governor's Executive Order protection.
